

FLO-2D Installation Instructions

Version 2009.06

The FLO-2D model installation is setup for 32-bit computers. For 64-bit computers it is necessary to change the model file name (see instruction below).

To install the FLO-2D model

1. Downloaded software: Unzip the folder FLO-2D-Model-Full and double click setup.exe.
2. CD Software: load the CD into drive. If set-up does not automatically run double click setup.exe in a browser.

To activate the FLO-2D model:

1. After you install the FLO-2D model on your computer, send an email to activation@flo-2d.com requesting the activation key.
2. You will receive an email with a license key that has the following format:
XXXXX-XXXXX-XXXXX-XXXXX
3. In Explorer, locate the FLO-2D folder in the C:\Program Files subdirectory or wherever you installed the FLO-2D model system.
4. With your computer connected to the internet, double click on the ACTIVATE.EXE program file.
5. Copy and paste the license key into the Dialog Box and click on the 'Activate' button.

NOTE: If you install the FLO-2D model on a computer with no internet access:

1. After you install the FLO-2D model, send an email to activation@flo-2d.com requesting the activation file. Indicate that you are installing the model on a computer with no internet access.
2. You will receive an activation kit in a return email with instructions on where to put the files on your computer.

For 64-bit computers:

1. In Explorer, locate the FLO-2D folder in the C:\Program Files subdirectory or wherever you installed the FLO-2D model system.
2. Rename the FLO.EXE file to FLOx32.EXE or something similar.
3. Rename the FLOx64.EXE file to FLO.EXE.

NOTE: The FLOx64.EXE program only runs in 64 bit operating systems like Vista x64.

Error during installation:

If you encounter an error during the installation process with a Vista or Windows 7 operating systems, either sign on as an administrator or try turning off the User Accounts Control.

1. Click on User Accounts in the Control Panel.
2. Click on 'Turn User Account Control on or off'.
3. Uncheck the box 'Use User Account Control (UAC) to help protect your computer'.
4. Reboot the computer and restart the installation.
